ECHO PEER RECOVERY AND OUD



Implemented in 2015 – House Bill 1006

Voucher program to cover mental health and/or substance abuse treatment costs for individuals without insurance or Medicaid

Reduce the number of individuals with substance and mental health disorders entering the criminal justice system

Recovery Works Funding Designations

6 categories:

- Re-Entry Services - \$1500
- Community-Based Treatment - \$2500
- Recovery Residence - \$8000
- IOT - \$3134.16 (approx. 8 weeks)
- Residential – Low Intensity \$2655.66/High \$5424.75
- Discretionary Funding - \$250.00
- Aftercare Support Funding - \$1500

Recovery Community Organization

Recovery Works has partnered with MHA and IRN to certify RCO agency and allow for peer recovery services

Recovery Community Organizations (RCO) provide peer recovery support services to participants who are in various stages of recovery.

Services begin with the RCO directly (does not utilize referral process)

RCO's are responsible for verifying eligibility

Integrated Reentry and Correctional Support Program (IRACS)

Recovery Works collaboration with Mental Health America, Indiana Recovery Network

Sequential Intercept Model (SIM)

- Provides a comprehensive picture of how individuals with mental health and substance use disorders encounter and move through the criminal justice system.

Five (5) pilot locations:

- Blackford, Daviess, Dearborn, Delaware, and Scott County Jails
- Slated to open more sites in SFY 24
