#### Implemented in 2015 – House Bill 1006

Voucher program to cover mental health and/or substance abuse treatment costs for individuals without insurance or Medicaid

Reduce the number of individuals with substance and mental health disorders entering the criminal justice system

- Community-Based Treatment \$2500

## Recovery Community Organization

Recovery Works has partnered with MHAI and IRN to certify RCO agency and allow for peer recovery services

Recovery Community Organizations (RCO) provide peer recovery support services to participants who are in various stages of recovery.

Services begin with the RCO directly (does not utilize referral process)

RCO's are responsible for verifying eligibility
